We had a great experience in our main church the end of March. One of our deaf young ladies was elected Miss Deaf Costa Rica this last year and represented Costa Rica in Florida. In Florida she was elected Miss Photogenic. On Saturday the 31st of March she was married to one of our fine men in the church, Franklin Cordero (deaf). The ceremony was conducted by the Deaf Pastor Walter Zuniga and was beautiful. To our surprise the couple was in the Sunday morning service and said that they wanted to start their married life in the Church. God is good.

Three of our young people, Diego Juarez, Cindy Fallas and Mario Phillips are leaving for the Middle East on an Exploratory Trip in May. Each one has to raise three thousand dollars for the trip and of course that is difficult but God will supply. Their future plans are to return to live there among the people and take them the message. I will tell you more on their return as these are closed countries and I cannot give a lot of details. Please pray for them.

Many have asked how we are doing with our monthly support from churches and I usually don't share this. We at present receive an average of \$2900.00 a month of which covers salary, working expenses etc. It is down but mainly it is because many of our churches are from hard hit economic states. We have put it in the hands of God. We have given over 45 years to missions and God has never failed us.
