First of all, we wish you a Happy New Year in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. Thank God that we could finish the past year with the work of the Lord here in Myanmar. Right now, we are in the more temperate season of the year but after the end of February it will be warm again.

Last November, while I was out doing personal evangelism, a car turned the wrong way and hit me. I was knocked down, not knowing anything for a few minutes. I had to go to a clinic to get medical attention. I am still having trouble with my right knee. After that I had a kidney stone. I prayed and took some medicine. I was able to pass the stone and now I am doing well by the grace of God. God was really good to us during 2011. We were able to share the Gospel with many people and baptize those who were saved. I always praise and give thanks to the Lord for your prayers and support. Because of your love many people have a new life and will go to heaven from Myanmar.

One of the most effective ways for extending our ministry is to train young boys and girls in our Bible College. This year 25 students are studying and five of them will be graduating in the end of February. Because of your prayers and support some of our students are going to finish their course and enter into the work of the Lord.

James 1:27, "...to visit the fatherless..." expresses our heart. Thank God we are serving 30 orphans at this time. Some of the girls and boys are very good in singing. Three of our orphans have finished their high school and are studying in our Bible School. Even though you never see them, God is recording your helping hands to them. Sometimes tears fill my eyes, because they praise the Lord and are so happy. It is because of your helping hands that this is possible.

My family is doing well by the grace of God and through your earnest prayers. We had a new baby girl on December 30, 2011. Mama and baby are doing fine. Now, we are four members in our family. We are really thankful to each one of you in having us as a family member and a missionary to the people of Myanmar.
