Dear, Family, Supporters and Friends,

I have had a difficult time getting into the mind set of writing my letter. My heart is full of concern for my son-in-law Darryl who I mentioned in the April's letter. I will share the burden with you so you can be in prayer for him and our family. Much has happened since then. To make a long story short he has been in the hospital a number of times the last three months. He now has 3 blood clots—one on the liver, the spleen and the intestine. A blood specialist has refused to attempt to thin the blood but is looking for a rare blood disease. This removed him from the transplant list. The liver team is still looking for help for him and told of a place in Chicago which may be able to help. Please pray for this decision if there is one to be made. They are checking this out now.

The work continues for Wonderful Word. I personally was able to send tracts to a missionary in Donna, TX as well as Edinburg, TX. Bro Hammett wanted copies of "To God From Idols". A tract telling of Dick Cimino's conversion from the Catholic religion. I also sent tracts to the Iglesia Bautista Bera in Greenville, S.C. The Spanish church was going to do a canvassing work of the city along with some supporters who came for a visit. The Pastor's mother wrote, "Thank you so much for getting the tracts to us in record time! These 3,000 plus another 2,000 we already had will be scattered across Greenville, S.C. this week. How exciting to be able to use tracts that present the Gospel so clearly!" If you have a need or want Spanish tracts for use in the states please contact me. Bro Gibson has been having a few health problems. However, he has distributed tracts to national pastors as they come by for a visit. The last ones were from Monterrey, MX. There are other opportunities to distribute especially in the summer as he and Marilyn have couples meetings as well as pastor conferences. They stay very busy with their ministry while including helping to distribute for WWP.

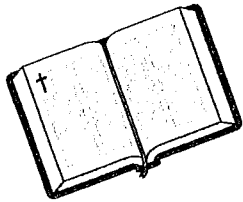
Bro Harman has been feeling better after several bouts of illness. A lot of the tracts he distributes are given or taken to national pastors in MX. Lately some have gone to Monterey, MX and even down to Guatemala. He came across a couple of pastors who want to get some new works started about 30-40 miles south of Falcon Lake in South TX. They have had no encouragement and no resources. That is one way the tract is used to open the door of invitation to a church service which can lead to testimony of the Lord to one who may have never heard. Soon this month he will be taking a trip to Del Rio and take many tracts and song books. The native pastors love the song books. There's only words but it's a great help in the services.

Please be in prayer for all involved in Wonderful Word. Larry and Judy Connor who do the printing. Jerry and Gloria Brewster who write the "Tid Bits From the Wonderful Word". Our distributors Duane Gibson and Ernie Harman and myself. I've recently learned I have a blockage in my carotid artery. No treatment at this time.

We have lost 4 supporting churches in the last year. I've only been able to contact one for a reason and it was a case where the church had to drop all missionaries. God knows what we need and He continues to supply mostly through generous individual friends who send when they can. Everyone is important, person and church. We are all working together to get His Word into the hands of those who may have never heard. Thank you one and all.

I prefer to use this number as I usually have it with me at all times. **Update your records for any correspondence.** The house phone has lots of unknown and robo numbers that I do not usually answer it and it is difficult for me because of my legs to get to it. I have to have it for the heart monitor.

I am so looking forward to the warm weather. We are having a day or two of warmth and then several days and nights of cold or cool temperatures in one week. Hopefully, it will get consistent soon.

At this time tracts are being printed. Bro Gibson is completely out of WWP tracts and I have not been able to contact Bro Harman. He has been very busy giving out tracts lately especially since making trips into MX more often. That may be the reason I cannot reach him. He may be in a dead area for his cell phone. I was able to give about 1,500 tracts to our assistant pastor who was taking a trip to Costa Rica and also some to our church for visitation.

We ordered paper about a month ago and found out that the price was going up very soon. So we decided to order as much as we could to get the benefit of the lower price. It was the biggest purchase WWP has made costing a total of \$4,200.00. This will produce a half million tracts. We praise the Lord we had that much on hand, but it left a hold in our reserves. If the Lord touches your heart to help refurbish the cost of the paper it would be greatly appreciated.

It has been a long time since I updated news about the family. I live in a downstairs apartment of my son's home with his wife, Emily and their 2 sons, Josiah 12 and Devin 7. They both are very active in their church. I am able to care for myself and have my own bills. DJ, 43, does have a watchful eye over me and I do need his help from time to time to sort out things. Emily is always around to see if I have a need. We do well together.

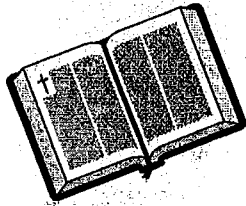
My daughter, Mishal 48, still lives in Harlingen, TX where she was born and raised as DJ was. She and her husband, Darryl 53, have four children. Nathaniel is 25 and is climbing the "ladder" to be a manager of a Texas Roadhouse restaurant. He only has about one more step to go. D.R. is 23 and works at Home Depot and is getting married on the 30th of this month. Rhonda is 22 and is working as assistant manager of a Dairy Queen and will be getting married Nov. 16th. Dylan is 13 and a very bright student at the school where his Dad teaches. All are Christians and have grown up serving the Lord. Please pray for all my family as times get difficult as is the case in most households. Without the Lord where would we be in this day and age?

I especially ask prayer for Darryl. He has had illnesses almost all his adult life. Doctors have prescribed very high powered drugs for one thing and another. As a result his liver is damaged and he is very sick. He can only work 3 days a week now. Time has come for him to need a liver transplant. The process has begun by seeing a transplant doctor and starting the procedure. This may take a while. He and his family need physical, mental and spiritual strength. ***"Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you." I Peter 5:7.***

Dear Supporters, Family and Friends,

I pray each and every one of you had a wonderful Christmas. Thank you for the cards and love gifts. Let us look forward to a Happy New Year. It's been rough for many of you this past year, but the Lord has given us a clean slate to start over. May we find ways to serve Him more this coming New Year.

Pastors, secretaries and missionaries please take notice. Add my cell phone to your contact information. It is 865-441-3181. The number in the letterhead is still operational but I get so many "robo" calls I do not answer all the time without a name showing up. Also because of my problem in walking I can't get to it to answer. There is an answer machine but many people do not wait the 5 rings before it is activated.

Bro. Harman is feeling better. However, it has been difficult for him to slow down and get rest when needed. At 75 it is time. Our minds can do a lot more than our body. In our mind we can still do the work we did 30 years ago but our body says a different thing as we age. He and Hilda took a load of Christmas gifts to his ministries in the state of Zacatecas and Coahuila along with several cases of tracts and over a hundred of our little hymn book. Someone also picked up 4 cases of tracts and a hundred of song books going to the states of Tamaulipas and Nueveo Leon. Bro Harman is building a display room in two different locations to get materials more visible as men come by. One is located near their home close to the El Paso border and the other is near the border of Eagle Pass where they usually cross due to the violence in Juarez (border at El Paso). Eagle Pass is a smaller border town 400 miles south of El Paso. The Mexican authorities are more willing to let goods go through to their people at this location. Continue to pray for his health needs, the rooms being built and the ability to get tracts and other goods across. All of these locations want more tracts and song books.

Bro Gibson is located near a very busy border location near Mission, TX. Lots of violence going on due to the drug cartels fighting for territory. He writes, "It has been more difficult for pastors to come because of the high fuel cost (\$4.00 a gallon) and cartel dangers". However, he was able to get over 7,000 tracts to the Northeast part of Mexico. Missionary Eric Hammett writes, "Letty, one of the members of our church, said a shoot-out took place and bullets were flying. One came down through the roof of her daughter's house, which is in front of hers, and fell on the bed. Her daughter was not there, and thank the Lord, no one was hurt. Please continue to pray for us, as it seems like a war zone here. Another cartel is trying to take over, causing a lot of shoot-outs in many areas." The Lord's charge to Paul can be applied to us when He sent him to the Gentiles. **"...to open their eyes and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me." Acts 26:18.** Many of us cannot go to the foreign field but we can support those who do and help those who supply materials to aid in their soul winning.

Some tracts and disciple ship books were given to Bro. Quesado by Larry and Judy Connor to go to a small town near Mexico City. I also sent some to the state of Washington to a Pastor of a Spanish speaking church. Many times contacts ask us how much the tracts cost. When we tell them they are free, they are surprised and grateful. Your support and love gifts are the reason WWP can do this. We could not print and distribute without your help. Thank you for all your prayers and support.
