Recently, in my morning devotion time I realized that one of the dangers of experience was trusting in past accomplishments and developed abilities. Judy and I received a beautiful marble globe of the world and the honor of our peers for thirty years of missionary service at the Rock of Ages National Conference. The first week of August I will enter into my 39th year of preaching and my prayer is my preaching and ministry will not be of man's wisdom but that the Holy Ghost of God leads me and empowers me to the end. Over the past thirty years pastors have allowed me to stand in their pulpits and share our burden and to preach to their dear people. To the saints of God that sat and listened to this preacher and began praying for me and my family and to so many that have given of their substance to be a part of the work God called our family too, Judy and I say again this month, THANK YOU! Together we have been able to say to the world that our preaching was in the demonstration of the Spirit and of power.

The past couple months have been packed with a full schedule. I have been privileged over the summer to visit a few of our supporting churches that we have not been to in a good many years. It was a great blessing to see folks we have known for years still serving the Lord faithfully. Summer is a busy time working with our staff men and men overseas with preparation for fall meetings. One area of ministry that is growing rapidly with new opportunities daily is the country of Brazil. Not only have several new states opened there to reach prisoners but the public schools are asking for our Character Under Construction Program, in addition a new door has opened to reach military facilities in Brazil. I will be a part of our annual Rock of Ages Brazilian conference again this year the last two weeks of August. Please help me pray the Lord draws several local pastors to the meeting and they will be stirred to support the missionaries and the work in Brazil. Our desire is to see the Lord increase volunteer involvement and to add more students to the Prisoner's Bible Institute.

Special Prayer Needs:

- There is a tremendous door of opportunity in South Korea. We are praying the Lord will send a missionary family to help develop the work in the prisons there. I believe the Lord would have me go and survey the prison possibilities and to meet with officials. This will be an extra trip for me of which I had not budgeted for, help me pray the Lord will supply the extra finances to make this trip the first two weeks of November.
- As many of you know a few years ago I had what is known as the fastest growing cataract in my right eye and surgery was required. Well, it is now happened in the left eye and is growing faster than the other. I presently only have about 20% vision and the first opening for surgery is scheduled for October 3rd. Our insurance will cover some of the cost, but we will be out over \$1000 and I have to pay all \$3000 by the second week of September (we have a cash-based system). Pray with us that all goes well during this time.
- With two trips overseas visiting three countries and traveling through several states the remainder of this year I estimate around 40,000 miles flown and driving. Please pray for our safety.

Webster's 1828 dictionary defines the word 'hid' as to conceal or cover up. The idea is to keep something out of eyesight or to prevent something from being discovered. As an American, I thank the Lord for being born in a place where, though great battles are being fought to squelch the proclaiming of the gospel, it is not hid, nor do we have to hide from the public because of fear of persecution or punishment. Because of freedom to share the gospel in the work place, I was personally led to the Lord. This freedom is not afforded to many worldwide. Many times, we take for granted this freedom we have here in America and often times we forget there are billions around this world in order to protect themselves and others they are driven into hiding. With the primary purpose of Rock of Ages to reach prisoners worldwide it is difficult at times to get free access into the institutions. Over the past 41 years the Rock of Ages has learned that when personal soul winning and open preaching is limited that the printed page is a great tool to spread the gospel. This past year we have seen thousands saved through the material printed and distributed, and through the thousands of lessons sent each week. Just this past year ---- men and women have written and said they accepted the Lord as a result of studying the Rock of Age Discipleship lessons. Thank you again this month for partnering with the foreign outreach of Rock of Ages by being a Titus Partner. Your gifts and faithful support help send the gospel to regions that may be limited to physical contact, yet the printed page can penetrate those areas keeping our gospel from being hid to them that are lost.

Help us pray this month that we may unveil the Gospel to millions:

1. 45,000 New Testaments and thousands of Gospel Tracts are on their way now to Papua New Guinea. Pray the remainder of the funds owed come in for this project. Pray customs clear quickly and the distribution of the material go quickly.
2. Forty-foot container is on its way to West Africa packed with thousands of pieces of material and Bibles. The material will be distributed to volunteers and national pastors to be used in prisons and public schools. This material will be used in several countries we are presently working in.
3. We have begun translating material in the Korea language to be used in the prisons of South Korea. Join us in prayer the Lord will first send a full time missionary to work with the Rock of Ages in South Korea. Pray the opportunity to take the material to North Korea may become a reality in the near future. Pray that the gospel presently hid in North Korea may be unveiled.

I realize it has been longer than usual since our last letter. As I write this letter it is hard to believe in a matter of days half this year will be history. It is sure is a joy knowing Judy and I have the greatest privilege a person could have and that is to first serve such a wonderful LORD and then to be the sent servants of God's children. Thank you again for your faithful prayers and financial gifts that make our service possible.

We have averaged about 5 days per month at home. Again the mercy of our Lord and no doubt the praying of God's people has kept us safe in our travels.

For the past few years, the Foreign Staff of the ministry (of whom I am privileged to serve with) take a week and come to the Rock of Ages Home Office to work around the facility. The Lord has gifted men with different skills and it has proven to be a great blessing. I pull out my old Air Conditioning tools, while the other men bring their carpentry tools and we go to work servicing, repairing and building. It is a tiring week but is always a great blessing to just fellowship and serve together. The following week Dr. Ellis and I take a few days to meet with all the ministry field staff and listen to what is going on in their area of service and how we can be more effective in reaching souls around the world. The conclusion of the week is bringing in prospective future leadership and teaching and challenging them to expand the work.

Judy and I then traveled to Georgia for a graduation service and church service. I would like to publicly give a special thanks to Dr. Gary Stewart and Dr. Clay Pawley and the board of directors of the College of Biblical Studies for the privilege of preaching the graduation commencement for the past few years. Again it was a privilege to see both men and women stand and receive a diploma for diligent work in studying the scripture.

I would also like to take this month and ask that you pray for several needs in our lives and the ministry. Please pray for the following:

1. Many changes and challenges are taking place worldwide where working with government facilities are concerned. Our missionaries are facing major changes in their institutions. Considering this, I feel it is important that I personally make a few extra trips overseas. PLEASE PRAY, first for my health. I am doing better physically then I have in years and believe the Lord is giving me grace to travel more. Secondly, with these trips so sudden I had not budgeted for the trips. Please pray for the Lord's provision.
2. Recently, Judy was with my daughter in Tampa, FL and they were rear ended in traffic. Judy is struggling with pain in her neck and back. She has begun the medical process; Pray there are no long term problems.

This month I would like to update everyone on John and Silvana Alves. Brother John was led to Christ under the ministry of the veteran missionary Jimmie Rose. Brother John has served with the ROA in Brazil for over 15 years and now leads the ministry as Director. Under his leadership the work has expanded tremendously with a rapid growth in the Prisoner's Bible Institute, several missionary families now working in prisons and the ongoing outreach of volunteers working throughout the nation. The Lord has blessed the work in Brazil and is using this family in a great way. But not only are there great blessings but there are many adversaries. Please join us in arming this dear family in the battle.

The past few weeks have been overwhelming for all our Brazilian families. With the recent impeachment of their president the economy has taken a major blow. The government raised fuel prices over 53% which led to a trucker's strike. Roads and airports were blocked and millions were lost in perishable commodities. For days our families could not get food or basic needs, on top of this many churches have felt the financial blow and are dropping support of local works which includes many of our Brazilian families and the Rock of Ages office and Prisoner's Bible Institute of over 2000 students. Please let us arm our servants with fervent prayer. Especially pray for the Alves family with health and financial needs.

Thanks again for being a faithful partner with us in reaching a world for Christ.

Last month I stated I felt the Lord would have me highlight the foreign national families that serve as missionaries with the Rock of Ages. This newsletter will focus on the Cristians'. It was not long after our first trip overseas to the country of Romania that I knew the answer to reaching prisoners would be through partnering and training foreign families. The Lord then led me to start the Titus Partner outreach in order to help financially support national workers and missionaries. Thanks to many of you that have been faithful to pray and give, the Lord has allowed the Rock of Ages see thousands saved and the Word of God spread literally around the world. As I thought on the above verses I felt the phrase "And foundest his heart faithful.." best described our Romanian Missionary family Mircea and Ronela Cristian. There is no doubt that after serving with the Rock of Ages for 24 years this family has proven to have a faithful heart towards reaching prisoners with the gospel of our Lord. Please pray for this dear couple as they serve the Lord throughout Romania and Moldova.



Mircea and Ronela Cristian were accepted as missionaries with the Rock of Ages September 1994. They were the first foreign family to join Rock of Ages and have faithfully serve for 24 years. Brother Mircea began working with the Rock of Ages a couple years as a volunteer in his native country of Romania prior to the Lord leading his family into fulltime missionary service. Under Brother Mircea's leadership thousands of inmates have heard the gospel and many have made professions of faith. Brother Mircea was a civil engineer with the Romanian railroad and Sister Ronela had background in chemistry. The Lord would use this great couple as they gave up their careers to serve their Lord. Even though being raised under the hand of communism, both were born into Christian families. Though bibles were limited and churches were censored, the heritage of both families preserved the message of salvation. It is amazing to see how God had been preparing this family. Not long after surrendering to the ministry the family would face a great challenge. Brother Mircea would be in a terrible accident that would leave him unable to walk and with a very serious head injury. The doctors were not sure if he would ever walk again or that he would even come out of a coma. Again the hand of the Lord was on the family. Brother Mircea's legs were crushed but with steel rods placed in his legs he is able to walk and has literally traveled the world sharing his burden to reach Romanian prisoners. Today though often in much pain and discomfort, Brother Mircea continues to labor faithfully.

Please pray for this dear family. Your faithful giving and prayers have resulted in hundreds of Romanian prisoners and prisoners around the world being saved. As with every missionary family the Cristian family is in need of additional financial support. Please pray with us about this need.

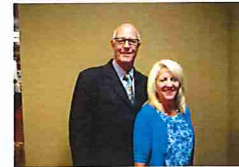

This April will mark 30 years that Judy and I have served as missionaries with the Rock of Ages Ministries and if the Lord allows, August of this year will be 38 years since I preached my first message. I preached that message at the Faith Bible Baptist Church in Century, FL, which was the first Baptist church I ever attended. Only weeks after being saved, Judy and I would join Faith Bible Baptist and we remain members there today. It was during a mission conference at our home church the Lord used the above verse to burden Judy and me for missions. We knew as members we had a responsibility to invest in the mission program of our church through prayer and giving. I was contented for a while but there was still that call to **'Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.'** I knew then that the Lord had plans for our family to reach a world.

When our Lord makes this declaration there are only eleven disciples present; can you image how overwhelming it must have been to this small group of followers? However, the command was stated and there was a world to reach.

After thirty years, with the privilege of serving with great missionaries, the Rock of Ages has been able to preach on every continent. Though millions have received the gospel through the printed page, and thousands have heard through preaching, there is still much to do and still the command of our Lord to 'GO'. Thank you again for your years of prayers and financial support that have made possible our families call to reach the world.

Please pray fervently that the Lord will continue to bless my health and that he would supply the financial needs to reach out more then every before.

I have been asked to attend a national meeting with our missionaries in Brazil the end of August and we are planning a meeting with volunteers throughout Europe the end of October. Please help me pray for these trips. Pray the Lord will send laborers for the open doors in these countries. Pray the Lord supplied the financial need of these meetings. I will be flying to Boston in April to assist in annual prison revival in Rhode Island.

As I write this letter we have been on the road for 33 days, with over 22,000 miles traveled. I was able to make my first trip back the Philippines in three years due to concerns with my heart issues. Praise the Lord the trip went great. The Lord gave me great health on the trip and safety as we traveled. I was privileged to preach several times on the trip with the Lord giving 37 professions of faith.

In 1994 the first foreigners, Mircea and Ronela Cristian would become missionaries with the Rock of Ages and for twenty-four years they have faithfully reached prisoners in the country of Romania. As I thought on the above verse, the Lord moved me to take this year and highlight the foreign national missionaries that serve with the Rock of Ages. This month I would like to share the ministry of Rock of Ages Missionaries Jun and Tess Monderin in the country of the Philippines.

Brother Jun and his then wife Joyce (passed away) began working with the Rock of Ages in 2006. Jun and Joyce worked daily in several male and female jails and weekly in the largest prisons in the country. Hundreds of men and women heard the gospel and many have been saved. Bible studies and discipleship courses were developed in several institutions. Jun and Joyce would be blessed of the Lord with two beautiful young girls, Betsy the oldest and little sister Jamie. Not long after Jamie was born her mother who suffered with severe asthma would suffer in a coma for several months. The Lord would eventually take sister Joyce on to heaven. Brother Jun would now be a single parent to two young girls. Though his entire world had changed, Brother Jun knew that the Lord had called him to the prisoner and he continued to be faithful to the work the Lord had given him. The months that Joyce was in a coma, the Lord sent a dear Christian lady named Sister Tess. She was the nurse that took care of Joyce the entire time she was bed ridden. Today this dear couple now married continues to serve faithfully in reaching literally hundreds of men and women behind bars. Sister Tess feels the Lord would have her use her education to take medical groups into the prison and teach basic health and hygiene needs. Please pray for this faithful missionary family.

Thanks to your faithful giving and praying, our Titus Partner Outreach helps this family with the daily needs of the work. Please pray that the Lord will increase their personal support, as more doors are open to them.

I was privilege this past month to take part in the ministries annual Coordinators Meetings. I was able to teach a couple lessons and be one of the preachers in the evening revival services at the Mt Zion Baptist Church in Commerce, GA. It is a great privilege to serve with such great families in the Rock of Ages. I was excited to hear from each man and his area of ministry. Please continue to pray for the Rock of Ages as we move forward to reach more souls than ever this year.

2017 Partnership Results

- We were able to see thousands of prisoners grow in the Lord through the Prisoner's Bible Institute material
- The Josh Hill Family moved to the country of Guatemala and have already begun to have several open doors
