

The past three months have been rewarding with different Bible camps for children, teens and adults. Souls were saved, believers baptized and members added to our church rolls. We also hosted a Youth Conference with the theme "What Would Jesus Do" with over 100 teens participating from Fundamental Baptist churches in our area. It was a life changing event for those who rededicated their lives to Christ and His service.

Our hospital ministries have also been a blessing with good attendance and participation from even staff members. The Cancer Hospital in Barretos and our Municipal Hospital (Santa Casa de Misericordia) gave us liberty to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ, conduct Bible studies and make personal visits to their parents. Since both have been Catholic Institutions since their founding this is a miracle and answer to many prayers.

Both Judy and I are in fair health. Judy is recovering from an eye infection caused by a virus. Her last exam showed no infection but has to continue to medicate her eye with antibiotic drops twice daily. I will return to our Cancer Hospital in Barretos July 11th for a routine checkup for my prostate cancer. Depending on the results of exams my doctors will determine if further treatment will be necessary. Please continue to make this a matter of prayer.

This year we are celebrating my 47th year of salvation and 45th year as WBF missionaries to Brazil. We are privileged to have been chosen by God to serve Him in this great country of wonderful people. We are thankful for our sending church, Oak Trail Baptist in Granbury, Texas. Our pastor, Reverend John Hawkins is a former missionary to Brazil. He was born and raised in Brazil so he knows the blessings and challenges.

After a brief furlough in the USA, Judy and I returned to Brazil on January 7, 2018. Our first two weeks back in Brazil, Judy and I suffered from the effects of the flu we contracted while in the USA. Thankfully, we are now in good health and able to fulfill our missionary obligations in our churches and their related ministries.

On January 11, 2018 exams in relation to my prostate cancer were good. I am almost cancer free, praise the Lord! I will have to continue taking medications and infusions until July, then, further exams will determine my status. Hopefully, the results will be positive and additional treatments won't be necessary. Please make this matter a daily prayer.

During the months of January and February, our churches participated in two different Christian camps, one for teens and the other for families. Both were well attended and professions of faith were made in our Lord Jesus Christ. In addition, several teens and adults rededicated their lives to the Lord and to His service.

Also, in February and March, we had our annual "Faith Promises Mission Conference". All had increases in their faith promise commitments and new missionaries will be added to their mission programs. They will also be able to increase the monthly support of some of their existing missionaries. Pray for our people to be faithful to their commitments and offerings.

Hopefully, in the near future we will be able to remodel the kitchen facilities, bathrooms, and apartment of Central Baptist Church (Igreja Baptista Central) in Barretos. This is a long overdue and needed project, and your financial help will be greatly appreciated and rewarded. During our furlough the churches we are active in have experienced a steady growth, a good spirit and God's abundant blessings. The weekly evangelistic services in the Cancer Hospital of Barretos and the Municipal Hospital have been fruitful with souls saved, converts baptized and members added to Central Baptist Church.

We were able to celebrate Thanksgiving Day with family and friends for the first time in many years. We're looking forward to the Christmas festivities and with our children, grandchildren and great grandchildren. We'll also celebrate Judy's birthday January 1st.
