Our new teen Bible Studies meet twice each week, and our students are getting involved in leading them. Dear friends and ministry partners,

Truly our God is full of grace, mercy and love for the people of Ireland. We are thrilled to share with you what He has been up to.

In our last letter, we shared with you the amazing work that God did in the lives of many teenagers at summer camp. Since then, teenagers have been asking to be discipled to such an extent that we have had to start a discipleship waiting list! To help guide their spiritual growth, we started a second Bible study on Sunday nights for those who are or will be discipled. Our goal is to dig ever deeper into the Word of God with them and begin to train them to be leaders in the church.

For the past several years, we have been praying for leaders to serve in the teen ministry who would have a passion for teenagers. The Lord has finally answered those prayers. In September, five adults in our church volunteered to help lead our youth department as a result of the transformations that they have witnessed! We will be working alongside them to train them in ministering to teenagers. Please keep them in your prayers.

We are now entering our third year of our one-on-one discipleship ministry, and our church has recently had several adults and teenagers who have finished their discipleship course. We make a point to honor their hard work and diligence in being obedient to the Lord in front of our congregation so that others will be inspired to enter into a discipleship relationship.
