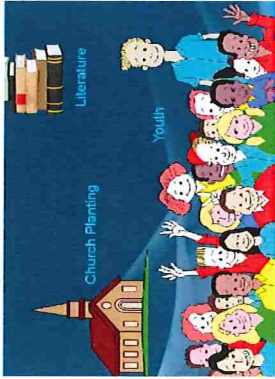


KING'S KATCUP
