Togo update:

We have kept in contact with many of our church members in Togo and have enjoyed hearing how God is blessing and growing the work in Bohou! One of our men, who recently finished his teaching degree, is undertaking a one-year government student teaching program. He has been relocated to a town 4 hours south of Bohou. He has asked for prayer that when his apprenticeship program is complete God might give him a permanent teaching position near the church in Bohou where he can continue to be a blessing and help the church grow. While he could be praying for a position near a big city where there are more luxuries and opportunities, instead, he desires to be closer to his village where he can see God reach his people!



Please continue to pray for the church in Bohou. We have been blessed to continue contributing to the ministry there, but they still have a pressing need for a latrine. Since our church was built, several years ago, the church has lacked restroom facilities and as it grows it is apparent they need some sooner rather than later. Pray with us that God will meet this need.

Ministry update:

Over the past three months, I have logged over 8,000 miles and had the privilege of visiting 28 of our supporting churches and many individual supporters. What an encouragement it was to be back with them once again! In the past couple months, we have been diligent about saving, praying and trusting the Lord for the needs of relocating to Martinique. Currently, we are up to 37% of our moving expenses and 81% of our needed monthly support. Please pray that God will continue to meet our needs. Our desire is to be in Martinique this coming fall.
