MALAWI

The summer ministries in Malawi continue to be blessed. These were the first clinics that Stephanie and I were not there for, because we are in Moldova. Kiki Cunningham is doing a great job leading the medical clinics. Kiki's medical experience has increased the professional confidence in this ministry.

The evangelistic day-camp ministry has exceeded my expectations, and the men have taken their responsibility seriously. Starting this year in June, our 12 teams - made up of Malawian ministers - have preached to 8,223 persons in the villages and 1,974 have made a profession of faith.

CENTRAL ASIA



Stephanie and I just returned from a busy two-week trip to Kyrgyzstan. The first week we helped in a camp for teens beside Issyk Lake in eastern Kyrgyzstan. Graduates from the Christian University in Moldova organized and worked as counselors in the camp. Attending were 45 campers from Kyrgyzstan and Uzbekistan. Since 88% of the Kyrgyz people are Muslim, many were invited from that culture. The Spirit of God moved in many hearts, and by the end of the week, they were ready for the Gospel. We understand, through the counselors, that 22 youth were saved! As far as we know everyone of the teens left having made a profession or dedication to the Lord. We are praising God for this work and are praying for the youth, as they return to their homes.

The second part of our trip was spent visiting pastors and our graduates from Moldova. We are excited to see how the Lord will continue to lead in this needy area of service.
