She had also been coughing for months and the doctors had been unable to figure out what the problem was until at last one doctor realized that she had an infection in her lungs. In my case, the doctor found that my pancreas and my spleen were very swollen. The doctor also discovered that I had a virus that was provoking a sickness called mononucleosis. For months I had been struggling with a very unpleasant fatigue and there were even times I started to feel depressed. Praise God, Tete and I have been taking our treatments and we are slowly feeling better.
