The Bland Prison Revival was my last prison revival meeting of the year, and what a privilege to see *five men surrender and profess Jesus as Lord and Saviour during the week!* It was an unusual meeting, the quiet conviction of God settling in several times during services. We had no physical altar, but a thick white line on the ground before the pulpit became our altar. One of the greatest moments (after seeing men saved) was perhaps the fourth night, when after the men began service by singing acapella "Revive us Again," then moved on to sing quietly, a single prisoner came to bow and pray at our "white-line altar!" I looked down to read and pray for him, probably for no more than a minute or so, but when I looked up, at least 30 men were lined up-and-down the altar on their knees, crying and asking God for help, for mercy, and for Revival! Oh, how we need Revival!

I was blessed to visit two supporting churches in the area, one for the first time, who have graciously supported for many years while we yet served in Romania! It is ever a privilege to follow Paul & Barnabus who when they had "...gathered the church together, they rehearsed all that God had done with them, and how he had opened the door of faith to the Gentiles." Amen! Then back home for Thanksgiving week, I was blessed to teach the Young Adult Sunday School Class at our home church, and take a couple of days with the family.

We will head back to the Rock of Ages office in December for end-of-year meetings, then after the holidays we will be back to Tennessee the first week of January for the annual Coordinator's Meeting, planning for 2020, then from there we travel to Georgia to preach a Revival meeting.
