

Your Missionary to the Himalayan Kingdom

Dear Pastor and Church Members.

MARCH 2020

We have started a fellowship in Dimapur with the hope of establishing a church by May 2020. The pastor will be a recent graduate of Nagaland Baptist College. There have been 15 to 20 people attending the fellowship in a rural part of Dimapur. This will be the seventh church established in Dimapur. Nagamese Baptist Church is now a self-supporting church and they are providing funds to the ministry. Our goal is that all of our churches would become self-supporting.

This year we have 116 students enrolled at Nagaland Baptist College and at this time 25 students are on track to graduate in April. We have recently completed a new dining facility replacing the old bamboo facility. The second floor of the Boy's Dormitory is now 70 percent completed with doors, windows, paint, and electrical work needing to be completed. There is the need for water tanks and lines to provide running water. At this time, the women's dormitory and the dining facility have running water.

We have bought land in eastern Arunachal Pradesh on the border of Myanmar. We have plans to start a school there within the next 2 years. Once the school is up and running, we can establish churches with the families associated with the school. We also established a new church in Arunachal Pradesh. We are looking at a new ministry area on the West Bengal state and Bangladesh border.

Changrabandha is the commercial gateway between India and Bangladesh. Miles of trucks in both directions wait their turn transiting the Bangladesh border. A missionary who can speak the West Bengal dialect can also communicate with the Bangladeshi Muslims. Please pray with us that this exciting ministry can start by this Fall.

The Mercy Home Orphanage consists of six children. Samuel is a freshman at Nagaland Baptist College majoring in theology who wants to be a missionary. Priscilla is her first year of college majoring in the Arts who would like to be a lawyer. Esther is 16 and wants to attend Nagaland Baptist College and would like to major in theology. Nathan is currently 12 and is in 6th grade. Jonathan is 12 and is in 4th grade and Khuluvi is 13 and is in 4th grade. The oldest member of the orphanage is Puvishu and he is a driver for the ministry.
