in Georgia. Next was answering a request from my Pastor to preach/teach a three-week series on Wednesdays at my home church on the subject of the dangers of social media and the cell phone. An honor to be asked, the battle was very real, but the time proved well worth it as the Lord moved in many ways over the three weeks. To God be the glory. Amen. The Lord allowed me visit a local school, invited by a local church member who is a teacher, to teach on missions. I thank God for the opportunity to invest some time in a few of the next generation.

February saw the annual Rock of Ages South Alabama Prison Campaign. What a privilege to have been taught by Brother Mike Kelly (those who knew him, know what I mean!) in the coordination of the meeting. This year the Lord blessed with 105 saints of God attending, and many more who desired to come but being providentially hindered, continued to partner with us in prayer! AMEN! I want to thank each and every one of you that were able to come for your partnership in the Lord, your sacrifice of time and money, and your fellowship during the week. And a sincere "Thank you!" also, to you who were not able to come, but who prayed! The "Final Totals" are attached to this prayer letter for you to see, but in brief, the VICTORY GOD GAVE during the week was:

- 105 Attending the meeting!
- † 209 Professions of faith!
- † 2,158 Attending services!
- Thousands more given the Gospel in the dorms & prison yards!

Of course, there were many salvation testimonies, a few of which I have also attached for your encouragement.

As cold waters to a thirsty soul, so is good news from a far country (Proverbs 25:25)...

After much discussion with the Pastor I work with in Nepal, we have a prayer request for 2020. Please join us and pray that God would raise up a full-time worker in Nepal, called of God to take this work full-time. We are at three years since the work began. The start was a completely new door opened by God in this Hindu nation. As best we knew, there was no other Gospel prison ministry of any kind operating in the prison system of Nepal. We began not knowing if a Warden would even allow the men in. But God opened the door, and today, there is news of 26 men that have professed Christ as Lord in Ilam Prison, not only attending weekly services but meeting weekly themselves for Bible Study! HALLELUJAH! To even think of reaching other prisons, we need a national man to hear the call of God and be willing to answer. \$250/month would support a man full-time (including all personal needs & the work). Please help us pray the Lord of the harvest would send forth a worker into His harvest. Amen.

We would also value your prayers for our Missionary Candidate Classes, March 16-20, where by God's grace we have one family and two men praying about surrendering to serve as missionaries with Rock of Ages Ministries.

COUNTY JAIL

As I walked into the pods at the County Jail, I met a man and I asked him, "Do you know where you'll go when you die?" "Heaven," he said. I asked him, "But do you know that?" He answered, "Well, I hope so." I replied, "So you're relying on a "hope-so" salvation?" I told him it is possible to know for sure that heaven is your home when you die; that you must repent of your sin, and ask Jesus to save you. "Would you like to be sure?" I asked him... "Yes, I would!" he answered, bowed his head and asked the Lord to save him right there in front of me!

JUVENILE PRISON

After preaching, one young man came forward to talk. As I quoted Scripture to him, he started to quote it with me... in English and in another language – turned out he was from Russia! He and his family have lived in the U.S. for some years and he spoke Russian fluently. The Lord was working and convicting him, he prayed and asked Jesus to be His Lord & Savior. After that we talked some more and he asked me, "Could I be one of you...? Can I do what you do?" Glory to God! Who can tell if God might not call this young man from a prison in Montgomery, AL to a surrendered life as a missionary in Russia one day!

ADULT PRISON

An officer was reading one of the ROA officer's new testaments, and I asked him if he knew what it meant to be saved. He said he wasn't sure, I asked if he would like to be sure and he said "Yes!" I showed him some Scriptures and the officer bowed his head and accepted the Lord as his Savior right there!
