To continue, "Effectiveness," the first of three themes that shape our philosophy of missions, I will pick up from our last letter. I Corinthians 9:20-22 Biblically shapes our effectiveness. The most challenging context in which we have ever worked was London. Our congregation had more than 30 nationalities. Keeping up with the immense diversity, complex worldviews, and cultural notes of our church, much less the community, could be dizzying at times. And yet, we saw there that intentional effectiveness mattered. It meant we should build a Gospel based church with sensitivity and understanding towards everyone in the church and community. What does this mean in practice? It means to be firmly grounded in truth with a message of grace and peace to the world around. It means to not allow personal preferences to cause you to offend other cultural ways of living. It means to study your neighborhood, your city, and the backgrounds of your congregation. It means to ask hard questions, and then to listen with ears to hear. It means to not compromise truth, and to graciously explain that very same truth through the prism of justice and mercy. Why all of this difficult work?
