To continue, "Effectiveness," the first of three themes that shape our philosophy of missions, I will pick up from our last letter. What is the Gospel?

We know that the Gospel is good news. At the most basic level, it is proclaiming the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Over the last few years, "Gospel" has become a Christian buzzword. It can be used as an adjective, a noun, and sometimes even a verb! However one chooses to use the word, it is critical to remember what Paul says about The Gospel. In Romans 1:16, he links the Gospel of Christ with the Power of God. In both our churches, and our Christian work, it is absolutely vital that we never stop proclaiming the power of God. Think of it! The telling of the Good News, is the actual Power of God to save sinners.

Friends, sometimes missionary effectiveness really is as simple as telling the greatest story ever told. Ministry can be difficult and complicated. But it might be worth it for you to check in for a moment and ask yourself how much time you spend proclaiming the Power of God. It really is the only thing that can save us. And, as I understand it, that's what missions is all about.
