## The Road...

As things continued to open up, we were so blessed to give reports & updates in July at services in Alabama, Louisiana and preach a 3-Sunday series praying God's people would be encouraged to press on! The ROA National Conference was limited attendance this year, yet such a great encouragement livestreamed. In August, reports & updates continued in churches in Alabama, LA, and we rejoiced to be home for our local church's first Revival services since COVID-19. September was a full month back on the road traveling over 3,200 miles for both services and meetings at the Rock of Ages Home Office.

## The Writing

Throughout this period, with God's help I was able to complete writing and proofing a set of material for the ministry, and work also continued on the final draft of some prison material that we hope will be of great use to reach prisoners with the Gospel of Christ.

## The Role of the Laborers

Nepal/India: Both countries remain closed as far as prison work goes. However, thank you sincerelyyou're your prayers for the men. Pastor Mardi in Nepal is now able to receive support and he and his family are now stable again. Brothers Thanga and Khailam in India are well, and in the absence of prison work have been able to get access to local schools and have seen several children saved during their visits to preach the Gospel! Pastor Gideon remains stuck in India with his wife, until the borders open for him to return to Nepal. They are both currently (by choice!) living in a temporary home, sleeping on floor, reaching an unreached village with the Gospel! They have seen a few locals saved and are now establishing a church to reach out to the surrounding villages. Please pray for God's blessing during this time, and for them to make it back to Nepal.

Brazil: We thank the Lord for the latest missionary family added to the national missionaries in Brazil. The Lord has allowed me the privilege to work with this family and guide them during their deputation period. Please pray as this family seek the local churches in Brazil for their support. Their state has just this week opened up fully after COVD-19 and they are able to start traveling again to raise support.

America: GOD IS STILL CALLING! We thank the Lord as we look to Missionary Candidate Class next March. That may seem a long way off, but please pray for one family already surrendered and planning to be with us in March, and for another family that just wrote and want to talk about the call of God on their lives!
