THE MISSIONS CYCLE

Not long ago, we heard from one of the first men that we ever saw come to faith during our years in Russia. He was from Afghanistan, and, after years of work and study in church, he returned to his homeland. Due to security threats we are unable to contact him, and instead must rely upon a very sophisticated process of waiting to hear from him. It worked for years. Then about a year and a half ago, we stopped hearing from him. Then out of nowhere, he reestablished communication, and it turns out that he is in good health, good spirits, and is still faithfully serving! We were able to send some funds for both evangelism and personal needs. It was thrilling to see, that after seventeen years, people are being reached in far off places, in ways that none of us will ever be able to understand until eternity.

On another note, we also discovered recently that one of our first professions of faith in Estonia, is now serving a prison sentence in China. What can we do? It is hard to explain to American Christians how difficult it is around the world. It is hard to explain what the missions cycle looks like in practice. Now, we see our own kids with global friendships, with prayer requests for friends scattered across the planet. Missions is everywhere. Once you start the cycle in your ministry or in your family, you never stop caring.
