Greetings from Ireland! We are so thankful for your continued prayers and support for our family. Let us tell you what God has been doing!

As you are aware, we have been under fairly strict restrictions for most of last year. We were moving in and out of different levels of restrictions which impacted where and how we could worship together. In October, we had to return to meeting online for all of our services. With the help of ZOOM, we streamed our services live over social media while allowing us to fellowship with one another privately after the preaching. Those precious moments have given so much hope to so many of our members and ourselves!

The Irish government announced a brief easing of restrictions for the Christmas season, and we were able to plan a few services at the youth Centre.
