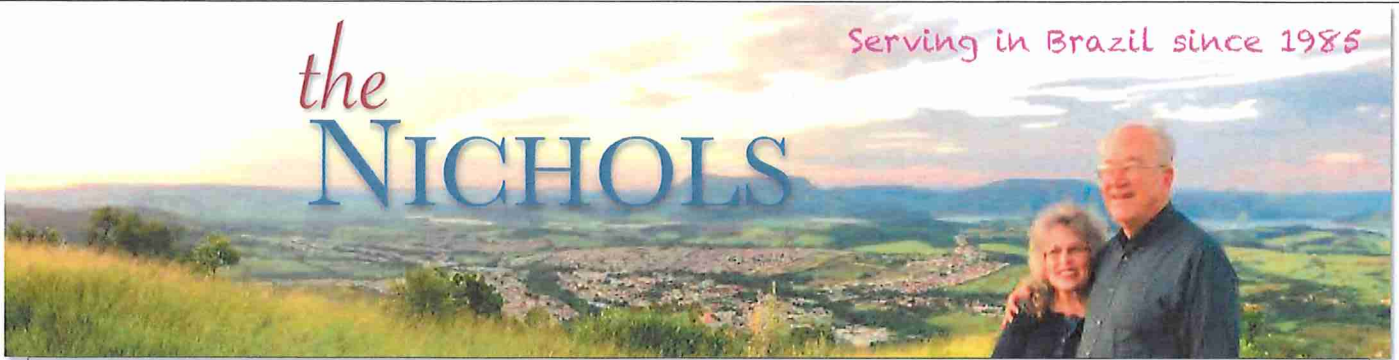

Anna, our youngest daughter arrived in Brazil the next day (15th) so we were quarantined until the 28th. This allowed us to spend precious time with our dear daughter! What a priceless gift! Christmas was quite different this year without being with the rest of the family!

We wish each and everyone a Happy New Year! We are trusting God to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think. In my lifetime things have never been more uncertain. However, I know in whom I have believed and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto Him against that day.
