From the Agency

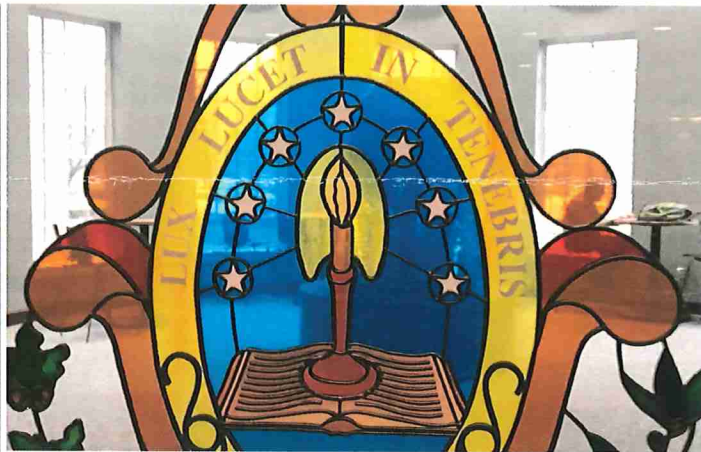

A few weeks ago, I came upon this exhibit. It is a memorial to the Waldenses - a Gospel believing people who lived in the Alps, whose roots go back into antiquity.
