As we press on through the year for Jesus, my hope & prayer for every saint of God reading this letter is that God might again touch hearts & minds with the blesséd truth that JESUS NEVER CHANGES and, THE IMPOSSIBLE IS STILL POSSIBLE WITH GOD! I thank God for wisdom and open doors for the 12th Alabama Prison Campaign! Coordinating this year was a great challenge. Access inside the institutions was closed, but we did preach at the fences of 6 institutions & broadcast services by radio to 2 institutions! A 3-day outdoor revival was held in the community, plus outreach to the homeless. In total, we estimate over 1,300 heard the Gospel and the Lord allowed us to see 49 professions of faith! These are extremely conservative numbers! One chaplain was asked how many can hear services. He said, "I don't know, but I was on the far side of the prison and we ALL heard!" That prison alone housed over 1,400 inmates!

Visiting a gun store, God gave the opportunity to witness to two Catholic men, and standing by was a veteran and a police officer. Nobody confessed Christ that evening, but I thank God for the opportunity to speak to these men, witnessing for over an hour, staying long after the store closed.

We had a week of training and updates at the RoA office, for some of our international missionaries. It was a joy to be a part of that week. But what blessed my soul was realizing as I taught, that in the same room sat two experienced, wise men of God who have served for many years, together with a young man of God not long surrendered, full of zeal and trusting God to do great things. Very humbling, watching God continue HIS work! What a God we serve!

I am thankful as well to have been busy on the road, preaching Missions Sundays & updating supporting churches.

India: The prison work is open again! Praise the Lord! And, I just got news from brother Thanga who sent me a picture (far right) of an ex-inmate who is now in Bible college! Once again, God had these men meet in the local market! The Lord has now allowed brother Thanga to meet a few born-again ex-inmates in that market - what a blessing!

Nepal: Prisons are closed. But brother Mangal, another ex-prisoner, is still in church and growing and I am still praying for a labourer! What could be done if a Nepali man were to be called to reach the prisons full-time?!!?

Brazil: Rod Dinardi's deputation in Brazil is proving very difficult due to Covid restrictions. It is possible the country could be locked down again. Please pray for brother Rod, and for wisdom as I work with him from the U.S.
