



"For your fellowship in the gospel from the first day until now;" Philippians 1:5

The Apostle Paul is writing from a prison cell as he opens his letter with greetings to the saints and leadership of the church at Philippi. On his first visit to the city, Paul was arrested which led to the Philippian Jailer and family being saved and a church was founded. Paul is giving thanks in his greetings for the fellowship he had with the believer from the first day he met him. The word 'fellowship' in the above verse was used in the Greek to indicate a partnership or a shared participation. Like the apostle, Paul I thank the Lord for all that have partnered with us in the gospel, some from the first day and some later, we praise the Lord for all that continue on with us! The end of May completed 30 years since a team of four would make a trip to Romania and the foreign outreach of the ministry would begin. Not a year has gone by since that first trip that we have not seen thousands saved on foreign soil. With three decades behind us, Judy and I look forward to what the Lord has ahead. With your partnership we believe the greatest work has yet to be seen.

We are seeing things open up here in the states; I personally have received my pin number to enter the prisons in Florida and every chance I get helping our revival teams is a blessing. Many states are still working out whether or not a vaccine will be required for outside guest. This of course will require some type of proof each time we enter or each time our volunteers help. Please keep this matter in prayer.

Most prisons and schools overseas remain closed to our ministry with the exception of Africa. We are concentrating most of our work in Africa while we wait on the rest of the world to open; the foreign staff and I have been working non-stop on preparations-for schools and prisons open. One of my desires over the years has been to increase the outreach of our Prisoner's Bible Institute students. In order to accomplish this the need to set up an office, employ staff and translate and print

material is the first step. Most lessons are then mailed to the prisoners, however in many countries we need volunteers to take the lessons to the prisoner and then pick them up when completed. Many areas where Covid restrictions are still in place have hindered the lessons from reaching the prisoners. We praise the Lord for countries like Brazil where we can mail in the lessons. We now have over 3000 men and women taking the courses in Brazil and many have been saved through the studies. We have also had many officers that have taken in the lessons and picked up the completed studies. Please help us pray that things will be ready to increase the PBI in other countries.

As I write this letter we are preparing for our Rock of Ages National Conference at the D. L. Moody Center in Northfield, MA. We are praying that the Lord will do great things in this meeting.

- 2. The Prisoner's Bible Institute continues to grow worldwide with over 5,000 students receiving free Bible lessons every week. Pray with us as we have set a goal to have 10,000 students over the next couple years.
- 3. Containers are being shipped with gospel material and Bibles to several countries throughout Africa. Our overseas partners continue to teach Bible based character lessons in their public schools weekly and are able to preach weekly in the jails and prisons.
- 4. Pray for the Josh Hill family as they prepare to leave for Guatemala this fall. Brother Josh will be driving a van to Guatemala through Mexico July 8. Pray for his safety and that the van will have no mechanical problems.
- 5. Pray as Ben Andrews and family prepare to leave for Papua New Guinea in the Fall. Upon Brother Ben's arrival, he will begin to work with the several church plants he has had over the years, teaching the men on how to work with their local schools and jails. We are praying we can have the Prisoner's Bible Institute up and running by the end of the year.
