IO started speaking to her in Creole, explain what we were doing in Haiti. She put her hands over her face and started apologizing. She must have apologized half a dozen times. That could only be the work of the Holy Spirit. She went from a raging woman to a calm nice person: as if a switch had been operated. It turned out that her dad was a Haitian and her mother was from Belize. She said she was very prejudice, but had respect for three white people and gave me their names. She said I would be the fourth!

It is sure good to know the Lord is with you at times like this. He said He would never leave us nor forsake us.
