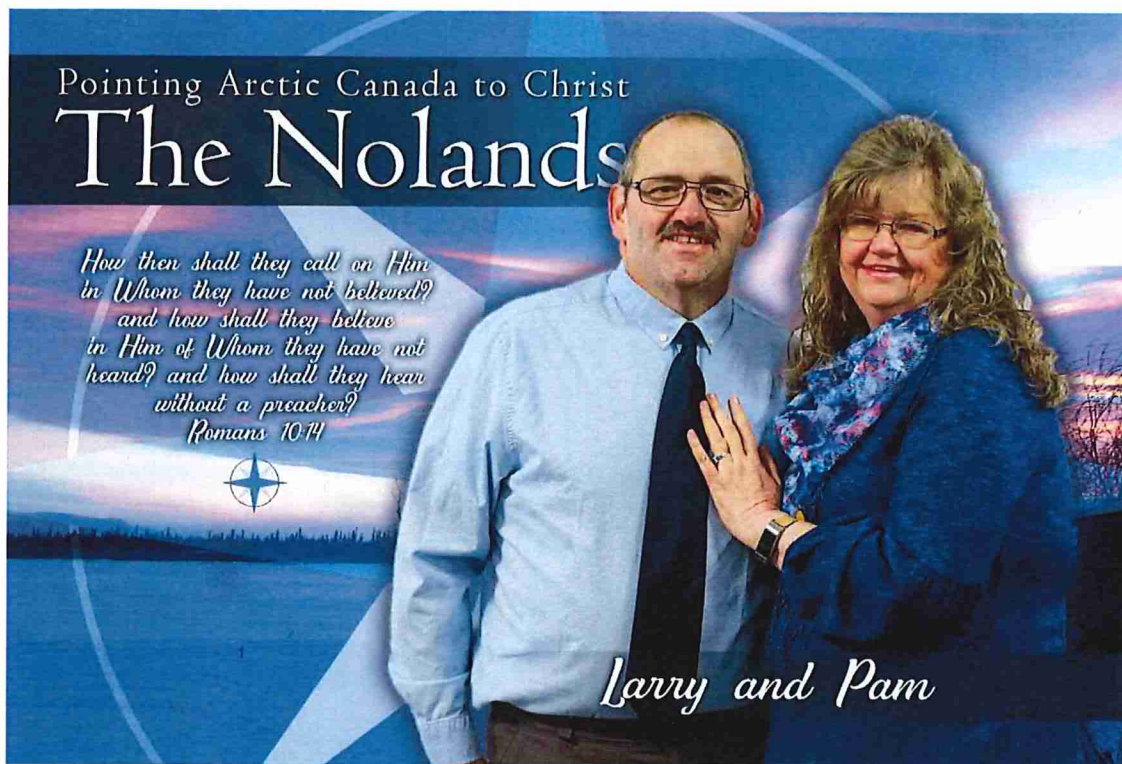


Thank you for your prayers for our family and ministry.

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Praise the Lord for your faithful prayers for our family. Want to give a quick update on Pam's health. A few weeks ago we were both not feeling well and tested positive for covid. She was scheduled for an MRI but that was delayed until she was finished with her isolation and feeling better. The scan was done and on the 16th we got the results. Two of the spots on her liver were smaller and the others were unchanged. Also the tumor in her esophagus was unchanged. The doctor was pleased to see some response from the the treatments.

Following the covid she began having problems with her blood pressure and heart rate being high. Her blood work and an EKG did not show any problems, so they started her on a medication Thursday that has already helped bring them back closer to normal. She is feeling much better now. Please continue to pray for her.

Both her oncologist and primary care doctor have cleared her for us to make a short trip to Aklavik. March 12 we will begin flying North to check on our house and have a few services with the Church. our plan is to be there for 2 weeks. We are thankful for Pastor Featherstone from Inuvik holding services in Aklavik when we are gone.
