VISA UPDATE:

The last couple months have been very busy! Last July, I applied for a visa renewal with the hope that the paperwork would be finalized before we left for the States in November. However, French bureaucracy proved to move much slower in France than it was in Martinique. In early December, I received a text from the immigration office that said I needed to present myself at the immigration office near our home in France within five days to pick up my new visa. While I was happy the visa had come through, it also meant that I had to make an unexpected trip from Portland (OR) to Paris on very short notice. It was an exhausting trip, especially since there is a nine-hour time difference between the two cities. However, God is good, and I was able to navigate all the new covid regulations, get to and from France and pick up my papers without any problems! Thanks to all those who have been praying about this with me!

REJOICING WITH TREASURE:

In our last letter, we had just celebrated Eunice's decision to follow the Lord in baptism and in this letter, we get to share the good news that her daughter, Treasure, has come to Christ! This journey started back in May when both Treasure and Eunice first started attending our church. Eunice was saved a couple of months later, and Treasure made the decision to follow the Lord in early

December. Please pray that they will both continue to grow in their faith! Please pray for their immigration status as well. It'll most likely be settled soon and will answer the question as to whether they will be allowed to stay in France or if they will be told to leave the country.
