Sorry for the delay in writing this letter. I was visiting in the States - churches and family. On my way back to Costa Rica, I became ill and as I left the plane in South Carolina and I went straight to the hospital as my left leg was swollen to twice the regular size. To be short, it was a bacteria that had gone into my leg. I spent eleven days receiving antibiotics. After the eleven days, I also spent another 5 days in a hotel to recuperate to fly to Costa Rica. Two of my sons flew to South Carolina to help me out. I can now walk but it has been slow. Please pray I will be restored to normal.

Our deaf group in our local church averages about 75 each Sunday. They have their own Sunday School and the service is put into LESCO (Costa Rica Sign Language) for them. Pray for the leaders of the group, Walter and Myrna Zuniga

Vladimir Sancho is a faithful Deaf Servant. He has his own Facebook program to teach and preach the Word. He has been invited to several countries and has gone to El Salvador where he established a deaf work and also went to Panama to do the same.. God uses the person that is willing to give themselves.

The 26 churches are alive and well and we have 5 missions at this time. God is Good all the time. Again thank you for your prayers and your faithful support.
