She has been seeing both an occupational and a physical therapist and she is now able to get around just using a cane for stability most of the time. She is always a blessing and encouragement wherever she goes, still giving a smile and a word of praise and testimony to all she meets each day. Andrena is staying with us for now and is a huge help to both of us.

The Lord has been so good to us through all of this. Though many times the storm is raging around us and we are drawn to watch it and become afraid, we have the assurance and comfort that He is right there, waiting for us to call out to Him. Thank you for your continued prayers and encouragement.
